Vendor arrival and check in time is 12:00 noon on Thursday, April 29, 2010.

Thank you so much for your interest in vending at The 2010 May Moon Beltane Festival! Below you will find our vendor policies; take note that, by signing the Vendor Registration Form, you are bound by the policies on this sheet, which are designed to create a happy and successful festival for all. As the organizer of the event, Mystic Moon reserves the right to refuse your stay at The 2010 May Moon Beltane Festival for an infraction of any of the rules and policies set forth and made public.

- Rain Date:** No rain date is scheduled and no refunds can be given.
- Vendor Spaces & Rates:** Merchant vendor spaces are 20 x 20 for \$125, which includes 2 (two) vendor admissions only! Limited APPROVED service vendor spaces are 10 x 20 for \$75, which includes 1 (one) admission. Spaces are offered on a first come, first serve basis. Your fee covers admission and camping for the business owners only behind the assigned vendor space.
- Parking:** Vehicles can be parked behind vending spaces. Vendors may come and go as needed.
- Vendor Assistants & Guests:** **Your fee includes your 20x20 space and 2 admissions only!** Beyond this, guests will have to pay the appropriate day/weekend rate and fill out an Attendee Form at Registration. Individuals accompanying you only for unloading or loading can enter without payment, but they must check in with the Registration staff. Assistants delivering supplies during the festival must also stop at Registration. We thank you for your cooperation with this policy.
- Courtesy Runs:** As a courtesy to vendors, festival staff will stop by twice a day should you need a couple of items from the store (e.g. ice, batteries, etc.). If you wish to take advantage of this service, please have the money and a piece of paper with the following information on it ready: your name/booth, list of requested items and the amount of money you are giving to the runners. Feel free to tip the errand runners.
- Registration Deadline:** The deadline for complete registration (completed form and payment) is Thursday, April 1, 2010. Unfortunately, no exceptions can be made to this policy. Checks should be made out to Mystic Moon.
- Fire Extinguisher:** Merchants booths MUST have an operable fire extinguisher on site for the duration of the event.
- Legal Compliance:** All merchants must ensure they are responsible for compliance with local, state and federal laws, as well as for obtaining proper licensing and/or service certification. In addition, you are responsible for obtaining your own insurance.
- Illegal or Dangerous Merchandise:** Mystic Moon and The 2010 May Moon Beltane Festival officially reserve the right to refuse admission to any merchant with any services or merchandise that are illegal or dangerous.
- Liability:** Mystic Moon and The 2010 May Moon Beltane Festival assume no responsibility for theft, loss, damage or injury to any person inside or outside of vendor spaces. All merchants are responsible for any damages done to the grounds from equipment, employees or vehicles.

Attendee Information: Camping & Festival Policies

To ensure our compliance with The Mariners' Museum Park policies, as well as rules and regulations of The 2010 May Moon Beltane Festival (MMBF), we require that all vendors, attendees, visitors and staff adhere to all policies below. This assures that we will live within the laws and coexist in peace, harmony, civility and safety. **NON-COMPLIANCE TO THESE RULES AND POLICIES MAY RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE FESTIVAL WITH NO REFUND.**

PARK ACTIVITIES: No swimming, fishing, boating or wading in any of the water anywhere in the park at any time.

ALCOHOL & DRUNKEN BEHAVIOR: Open consumption and/or containers of alcohol are NOT permitted! Drunken and disorderly behavior will be grounds for expulsion from the event.

DRUGS & ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES: There will be absolutely NO drugs or illegal substances at MMBF or anywhere in the park. Violators will be arrested!

CHILDREN: Be mindful that some Beltane activities can be of a mature theme. You MUST sign in each minor attending MMBF with you. **Minors must be supervised by their parent/guardian AT ALL TIMES and are not permitted at the Fire Circle after 11 pm.**

WEAPONS: No firearms or weapons are permitted in the park or at MMBF with the exception of costume or peace-bound blades. Compliance to the law is the wearer's sole responsibility.

RESPECT: We expect everyone at this event to be respectful to all life—plant, animal and human.

LITTERING & TRASH: No littering will be permitted AT ALL—including the dropping of cigarette butts. Trash receptacles and butt cans are provided. Littering goes against everything we believe in as Tribes of the Earth.

GATE: The gate is locked at midnight and non-campers must leave by that time. Any day-trippers in the park after that time will be required to pay the fee for a full weekend of camping (\$65).

CLOTHING: Clothing IS REQUIRED and must be legal in public.

NOISE: Noise curfew is 12 a.m. until 8 a.m. and is in place to be respectful and considerate of residents nearby, as well as MMBF attendees. MMBF staff and park security will determine any situations concerning noise and have final say.

VEHICLES: All campers and vehicles MUST be moved to designated parking lot after unloading, unless you will be camping in the vehicle and it will not be moved until you are leaving at the end of the festival.

SPECIAL NEEDS: If you have any particular needs or special requirements due to disabilities, please contact any MMBF staff member so we can do our best to accommodate and assist you. There will be handicapped toilet facilities.

CAMPFIRES & CAMPSITES: Campsites are to be kept free of trash/clutter. Small personal campfires are permitted in small containers, such as portable pits and grills. All fires in campsites are your responsibility. Museum and MMBF staff have final authority for approval of personal fires.

PETS: Pets are allowed and MUST remain on a leash at all times. Owners are fully responsible for ANY problems caused by their pet such as excessive barking, damage or injury. **Owners MUST scoop all poop!**

SACRED SPACE: Our Fire/Drum Circle is sacred space! All drummers, dancers and attendees should know the rules of etiquette at the fire circle and conduct themselves accordingly. If you are unsure of anything, feel free to ask someone.

FIRE CIRCLE: You may NOT throw ANYTHING into the fire! The Fire Circle Team is solely responsible for tending to and caring for the fire. **NO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS ARE PERMITTED TO TEND THE FIRE!**

FACILITIES: There is no electricity and there are no showers at the park. There is a water faucet near the pavilion. Bring your own chairs as seating at the pavilion is limited.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: There will be a food vendor on site. You are permitted to bring your own coolers, food and drinks.

RAINDATE: There is no rain date and no refunds can be issued due to weather.

REFUNDS: Unfortunately, no refunds for festival entry can be issued.
