Attendee Information: Camping & Festival Policies

To ensure our compliance with The Mariners' Museum Park policies, as well as rules and regulations of The 2018 May Moon Beltane Festival (MMBF), we require that all vendors, attendees, visitors and staff adhere to all policies below. This assures that we will live within the laws and coexist in peace, harmony, civility and safety. The Mariners' Museum staff and security officers have final authority on all matters.

NON-COMPLIANCE TO THESE RULES AND POLICIES MAY RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE FESTIVAL WITH NO REFUND.

Convicted Sex Offenders are NOT permitted to visit, attend or vend this event!

CHILDREN: Some Beltane activities are of a mature theme. You **MUST** sign in each minor attending with you. Minors must be supervised by their parent/guardian AT ALL TIMES and may not be at the Fire Circle after 10 pm.

DRUGS & ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES: There will be absolutely **NO** drugs or illegal substances at MMBF or anywhere in the park. Usage will result in expulsion from the event with no refund and possible prosecution.

PARKING: All vehicles must stop for parking staff in front of the registration tent.

PETS: NO Pets, SERVICE ANIMALS permitted ONLY.

ALCOHOL & DRUNKEN BEHAVIOR: No alcohol allowed on premises.

PARK ACTIVITIES: No swimming, fishing, boating or wading in any of the water anywhere in the park at any time.

WEAPONS: NO METAL BLADES or FIREARMS are permitted to be sold, worn, or carried in/on the park property at MMBF. This includes metal reproduction pieces for costumes.

RESPECT: We expect everyone at this event to be respectful to all life—plant, animal and human.

LITTERING & TRASH: No littering will be permitted AT ALL—including the dropping of cigarette butts. Trash receptacles and butt cans are provided. Littering goes against everything we believe in as Tribes of the Earth.

GATE: The gate is locked at midnight and non-campers must leave by that time. Any day-trippers in the park after that time will be required to pay the fee for the entire weekend.

CLOTHING: Clothing IS REQUIRED and must be legal in public.

NOISE: Strict noise curfew is 10 pm until 8 a.m. MMBF staff will determine any situations concerning noise. Staff members can show you general areas for different campers (e.g. quiet sites, not-so-quiet sites, etc.).

PERSONAL GROUP WORKINGS: Out of respect for the fire circle and to build more unified energy, no drumming is permitted anywhere other than the fire circle area. We encourage personal group workings as long as they don't travel outside your own campsite and interrupt festival events.

VEHICLES: DO NOT drive on wet grass. All campers and vehicles MUST be moved to designated parking after unloading.

SPECIAL NEEDS: If you have any particular needs or special requirements due to disabilities, please contact any MMBF staff member so we can do our best to accommodate and assist you. There will be handicapped toilet facilities.

CAMPING & CAMPFIRES: Small campfire will be permitted however, Campfire Pits MUST be approved by our Staff Team. Campsites are to be kept free of trash/clutter. All fires in campsites are your responsibility. **NO CAMPFIRE is to be left unattended at any time.**

SACRED SPACE: Our Fire/Drum Circle is sacred space! All drummers, dancers and attendees should know the rules of etiquette at the fire circle and conduct themselves accordingly.

FIRE CIRCLE: The Fire Circle Team is solely responsible for tending to and caring for the fire. **NO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS MAY TEND THE FIRE AT CIRCLE OR THROW ANYTHING IN IT!**

FACILITIES: There is no electricity and there are no showers at the park. There is a water faucet near the pavilion. Bring your own chairs as seating at the pavilion is limited.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: There will be a food vendor on site. You are welcome to bring your own coolers, food and drinks.

RAINDATE: There is no rain date and no refunds will be issued due to weather.

REFUNDS: Unfortunately, no refunds for festival entry can be issued.
